Policy Statement

Commercial Use of Open Space in Corby Glen

Purpose

To ensure that if the Parish Council is approached by any commercial organisation who wish to use public space in the village for commercial gain, the following principles will be applied:

- The organisation will be advised of the Lincolnshire County Council Road Closure policy and advised to contact the County Council to gain formal permission to close roads, if applicable for the proposed activity.
- The organisation will be advised to contact residents and businesses
 potentially affected by the proposed activity, in good time and before
 the activity is committed, to explain the planned activity, its duration, its
 impact on residents and businesses, and arrangements being made to
 minimise the impact on both.
- The organisation will be responsible for contacting relevant emergency services, and utilities such as bus companies, to obtain clearance where necessary.
- The Parish Council will only be able to approve activity which would be held on land managed by the Parish Council, currently extending to the Village Green.
- Village organisations approaching the Parish Council, which are planning events, or activities using public space in the village, will be advised to follow the same principles.
